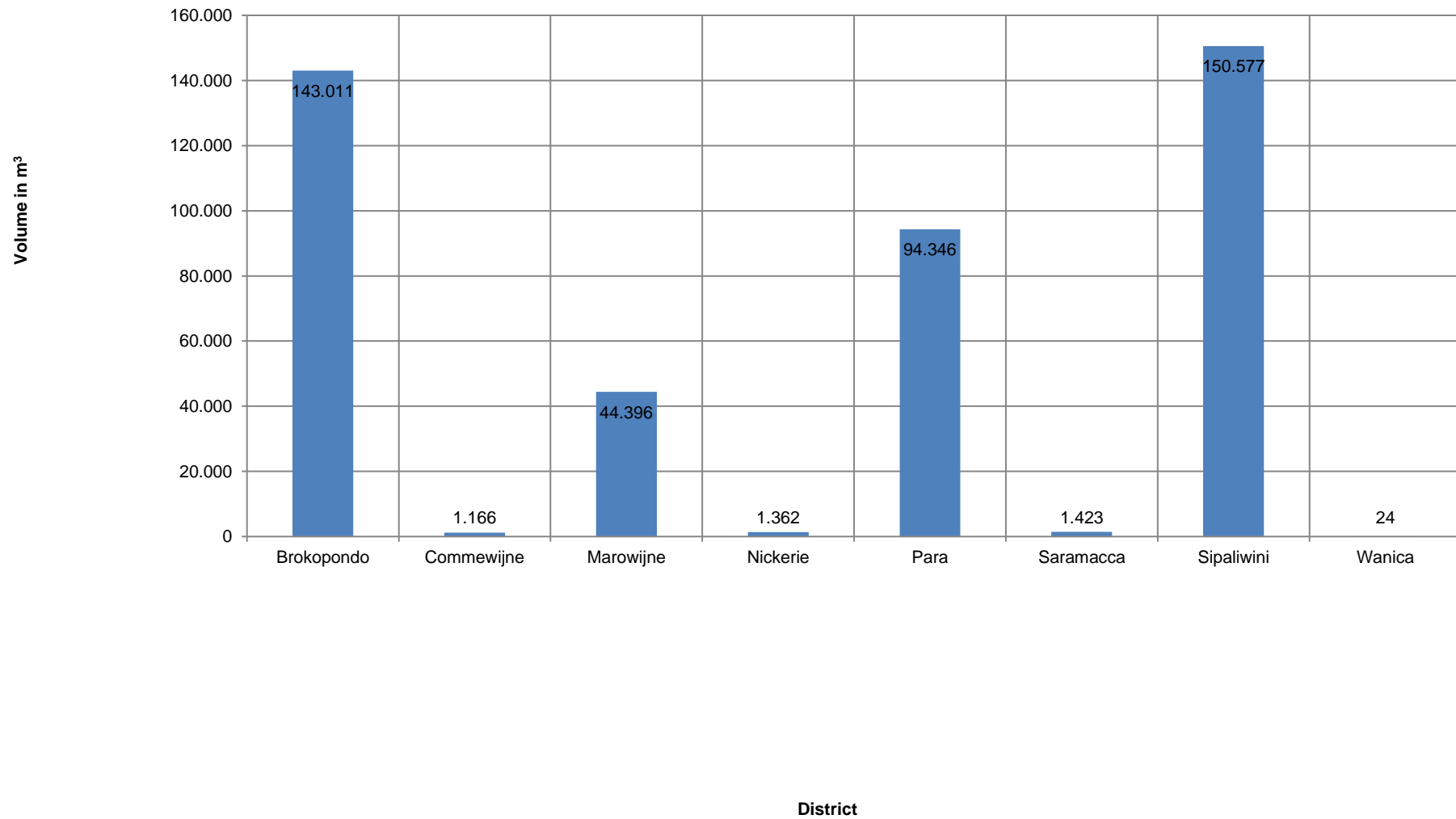

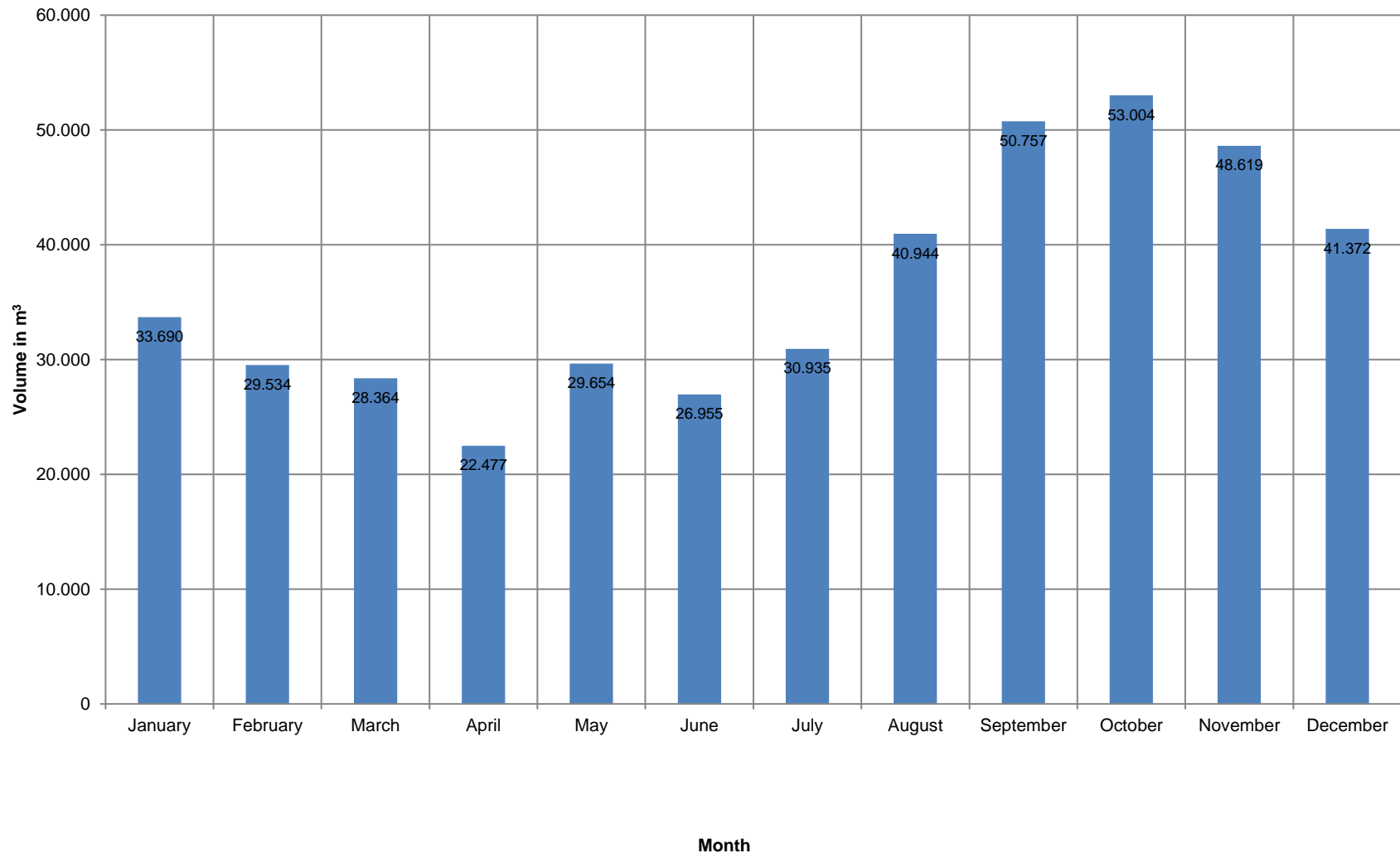

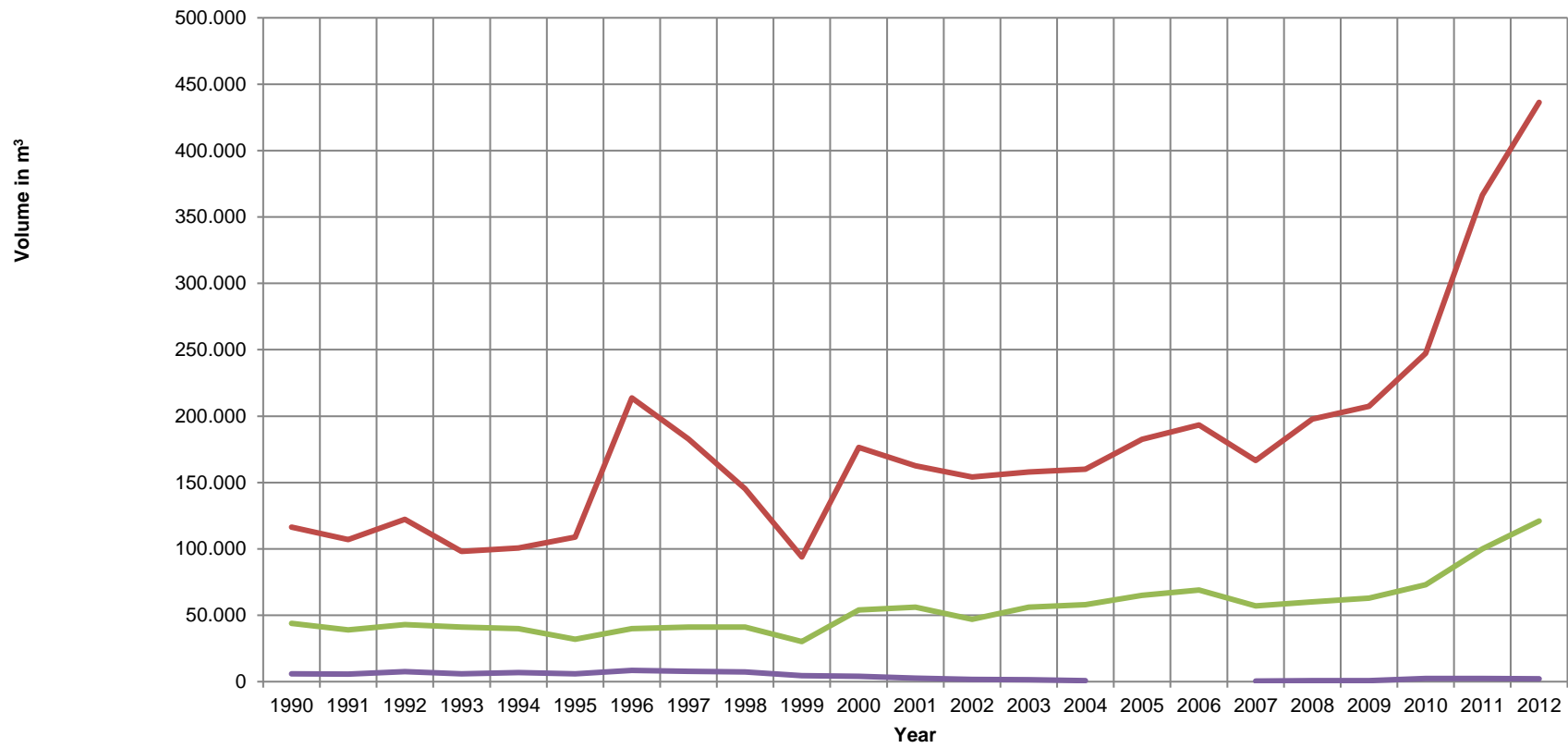

— Roundwood — Sawnwood — Plywood

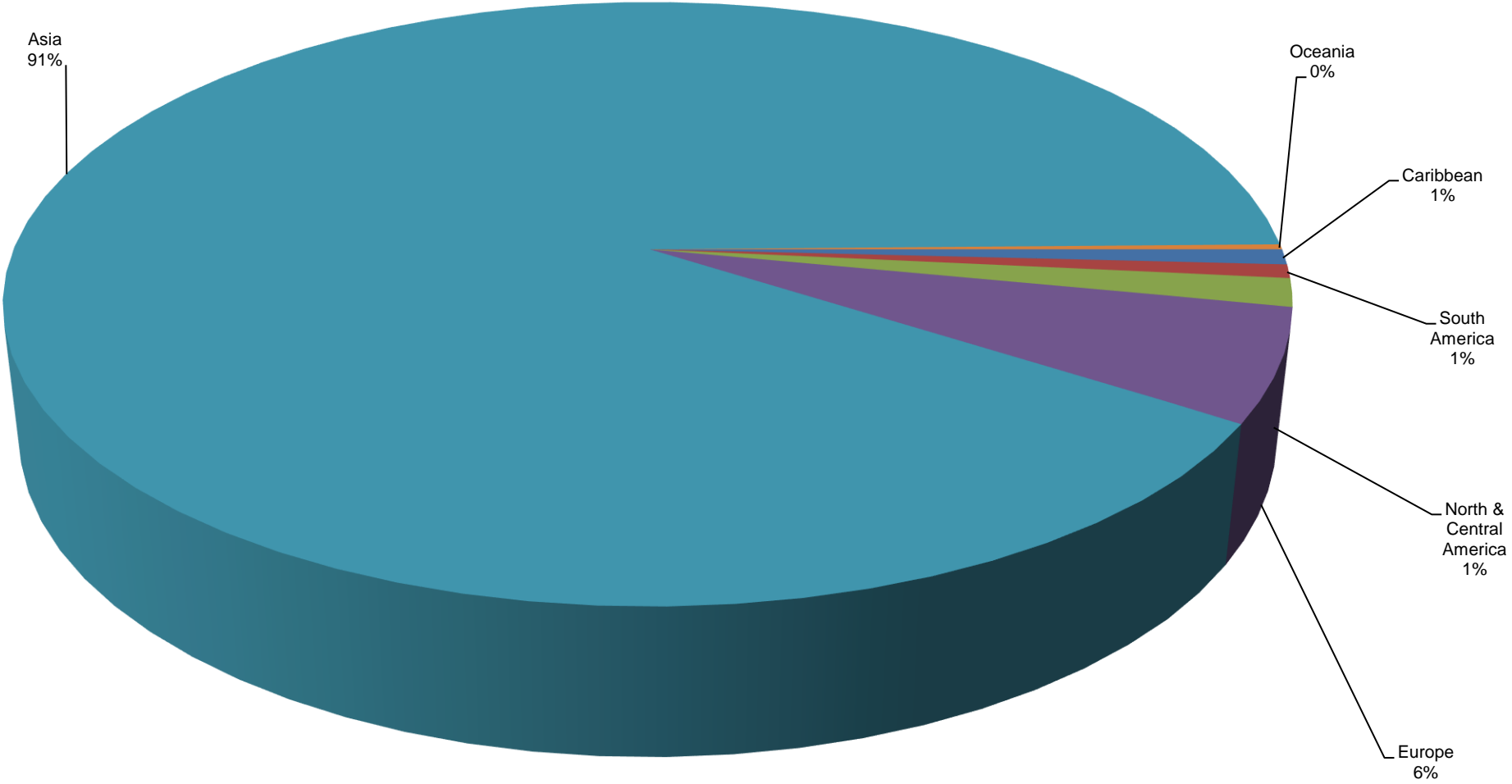

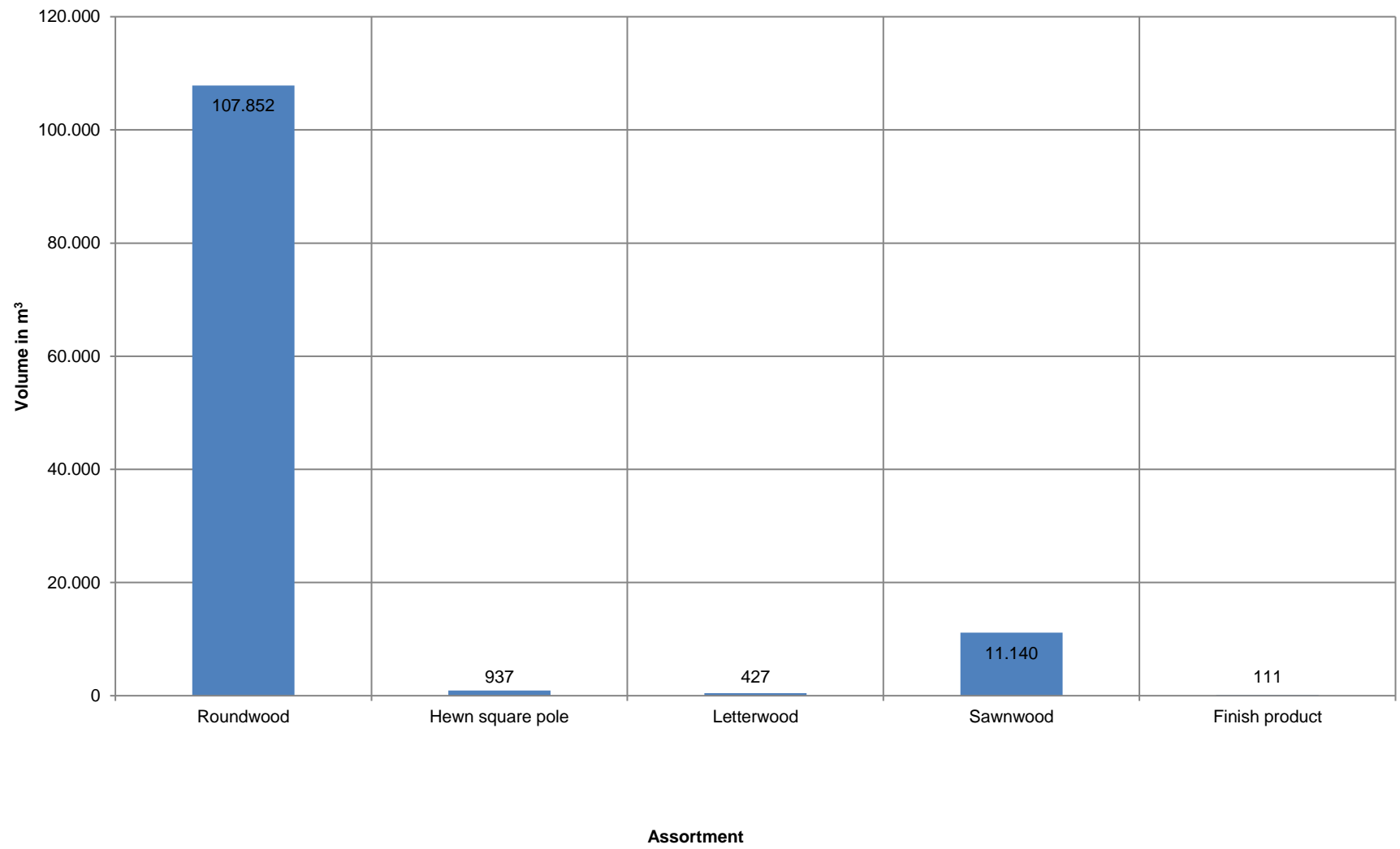

Figure 5. Timber export volume per assortment in 2012





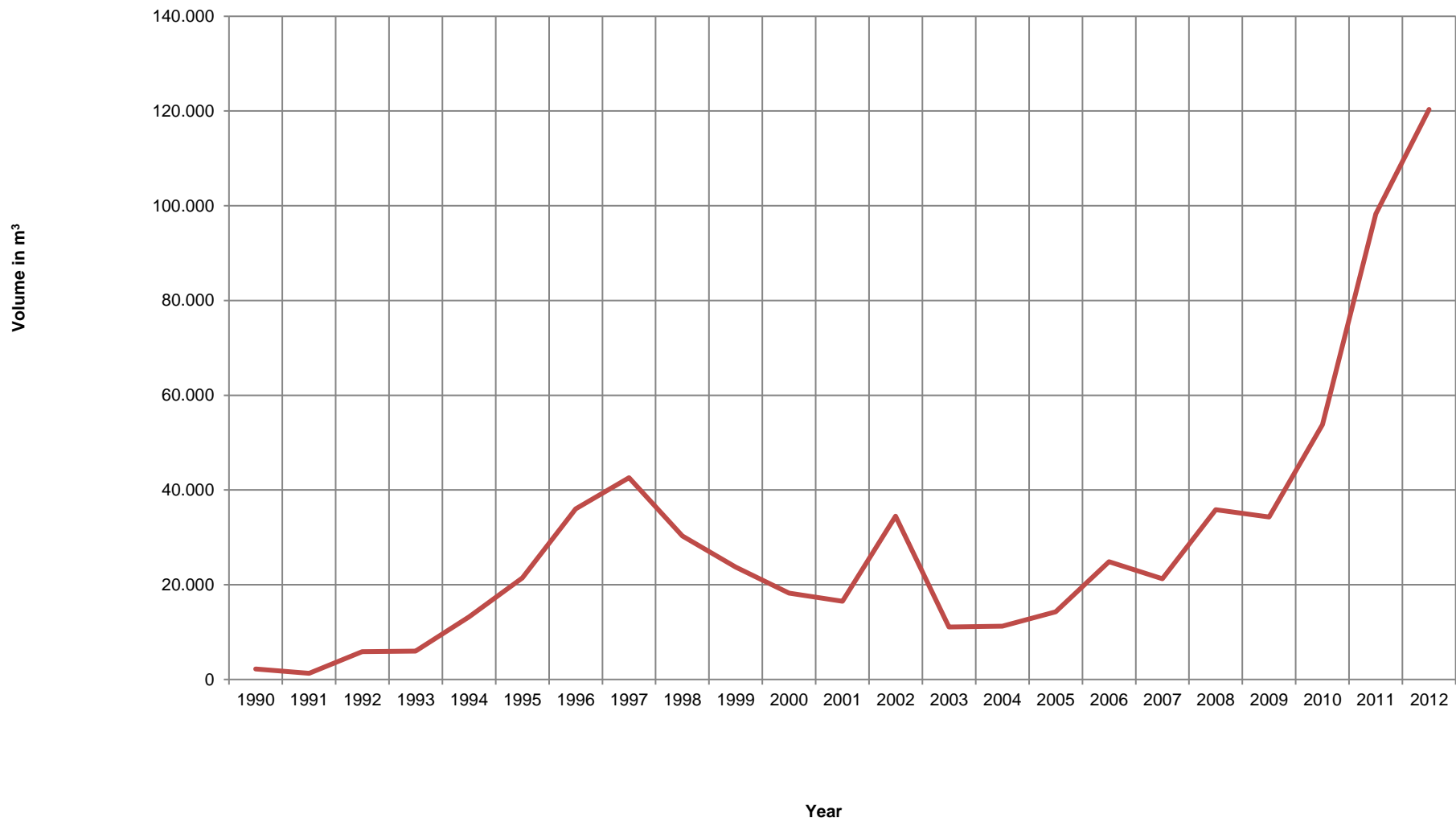
